My only message to our children is "children fly like kites and paint the newsletter canvas with your colours."



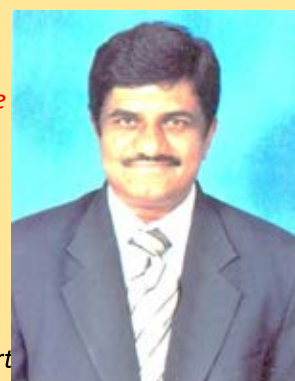
